

Walker granular stone was supplied to support the construction of the Hydro One new double-circuit 230 kilovolt transmission line from the Chatham Switching Station in Chatham-Kent to the Lakeshore Switching Station in Lakeshore. Quarry Updates

McGregor Quarry started construction in December 2023 for the installation of an engineered tunnel under Howard Ave. The tunnel will connect the Walker McGregor Quarry that is currently active on the west side of Howard Ave, and the soon-to-become active east-side.

In preparation for the tunnel construction, Walker has installed a detour road to allow for community continued use of Howard Ave. Walker received approval from the County to allow traffic on the detour road which marks a step in the right direction and allows the contractor to safely begin the excavation of the existing portion of Howard Ave. Stay tuned for more updates on this project in early summer 2024.
